### Jones Street High Pressure Water Tank

The Jones Street High Pressure Water Tank has undergone a one year 'seismic upgrade' that is now complete. The Tank holds 750,000 gallons of fresh water that can be remotely activated, if needed, by the SF Water Department in the event the City requires for firefighting purposes.

If you pass a fire hydrant painted 'blue' that is a high pressure hydrant that is fed from our Jones Street Tank.

The Jones Street High Pressure Tank is one of two high pressure tanks (the other is Ashbury) in the City that was constructed between 1909-1913 in response to the devastating earthquake/fire of 1906.

The last time the Jones Street Water Tank was used was in 1989 during the Loma Prieta Earthquake.

The Jones Street Tank Garden was renovated in 2003 as a partnership between the Nob Hill Association and the S.F. Fire Department.




